

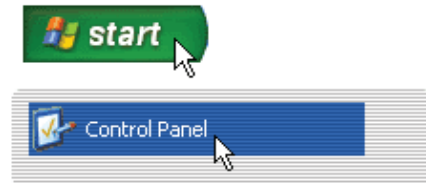
Creating a PC screen saver

It doesn't matter if you're a computer whiz or a beginner. Just follow these easy steps to personalize your desktop.

If you don't have pictures in the My Pictures Slideshow, you'll have to add them first. To do this, double click your hard drive, then open the Screen Saver folder and add pictures by dragging and dropping them from another folder or your desktop into the Screen Saver.

Creating a screen saver on a Windows XP system

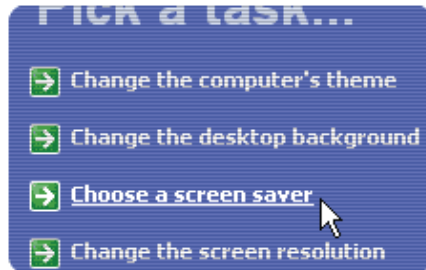
1 - On your desktop, click Start, then click Control Panel. The Control Panel window pops up.



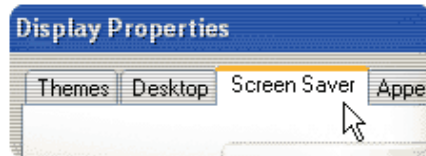
2 - Click Appearance and Themes. The Pick a Task menu appears.



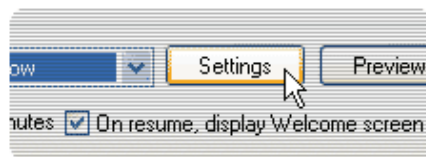
3 - Click Choose a Screen Saver. The Display Properties window appears.



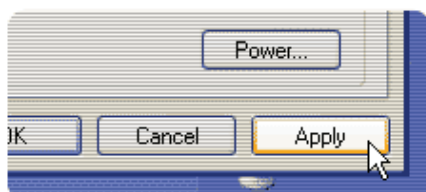
4 - Click the Screen Saver tab, then go to the Screen Saver pull-down menu and scroll down to My Pictures Slideshow.



5 - Click the Settings button to choose how often pictures should change, how large they should be, the transition effects you want and how long until the Screen Saver appears. Then click OK.



6 - Click Apply to preview your Screen Saver Slide Show in the Display Properties window. If you're pleased with your choices, click OK.



Note: Your new screen saver won't appear until your PC has been idle for the number of minutes you selected in Step 5.
